Men's Retreat: The Conference Men's Retreat is coming up April 12-14, 2024. Pick up a form in the lobby with more information and the registration info.

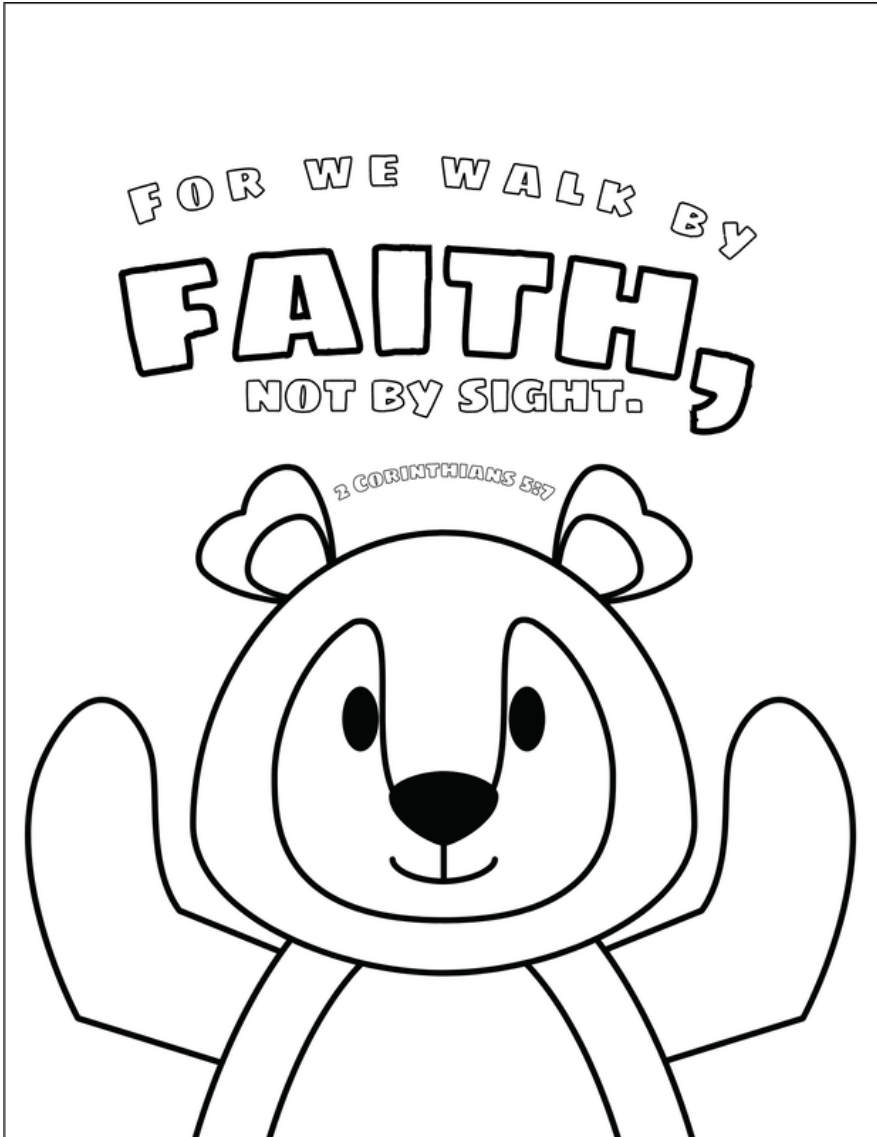

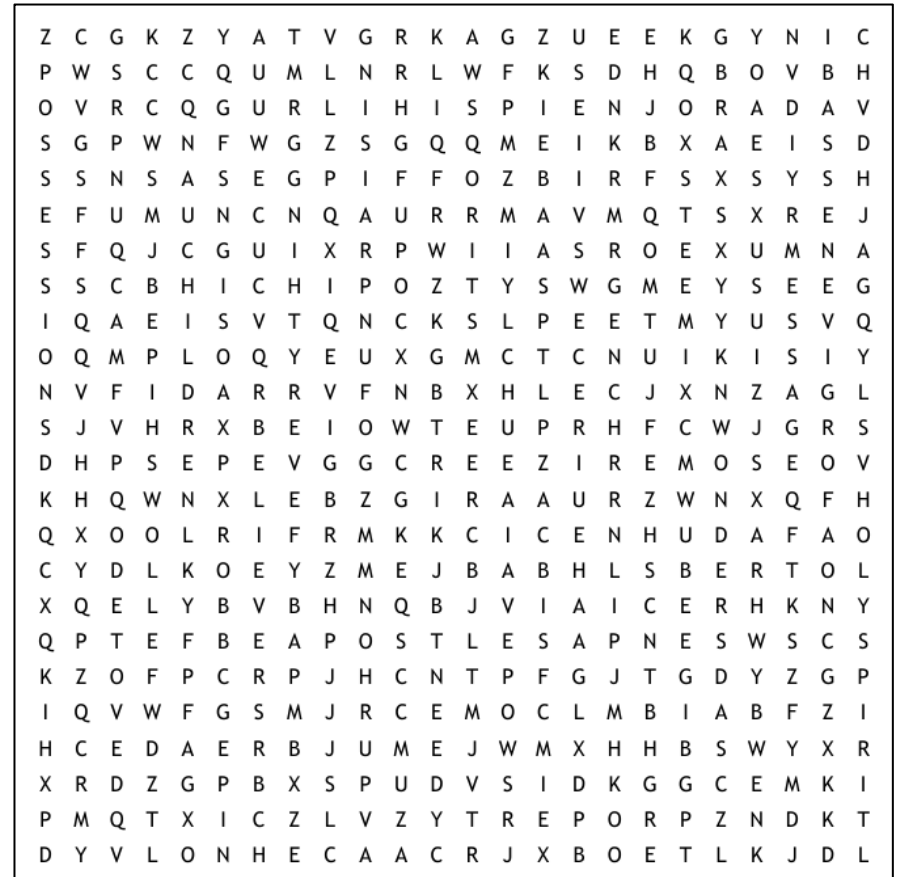
Activity boxes are available for children to use during church. They are located above the coat rack in the foyer. Please notify the greeter or a children's ministry team member, if any of the items need attention.
